She has published the main results of her research in leading journals, such as Journal of Environmental Economics & Management, Resource & Energy Economics, or Environmental & Resource Economics, among others. Carmen has been the research leader in several projects funded by the Spanish Ministry of Economics, and she has presented her work in more than hundred seminars, workshops and conferences around the world.
