FUYUHIKO TAMANOI

Dr. Tamanoi received PhD in Molecular Biology from Nagoya University in 1977 and has carried out postdoctoral research at Harvard Medical School. He worked as a senior investigator and section head at Cold Spring Harbor Laboratory from 1980-1985. He became Assistant Professor and then Associate Professor at the University of Chicago (1985-1993). He moved to University of California at Los Angeles (UCLA) in 1993. Since 1997, he has been Full Professor at UCLA. In April of 2017, he received joint appointment at the Institute for Integrated Cell-Material Sciences, Institute for Advanced Study, Kyoto University, Japan.

Dr. Tamanoi served as Director of Signal Transduction and Therapeutics program at Jonsson Comprehensive Cancer Center and as Research Director of California NanoSystems Institute. His research is focused on mesoporous silica nanoparticles and their use in cancer therapy.
