He received a Civil Engineering degree from PUC Chile and M.Sc. and Ph.D. degrees in Economics from MIT. His research work concentrates on industrial organization, environmental and resource economics and has been published in the leading academic journals (AER and JPE). In 2007 he was named “Chilean Economist of the Year” by El Mercurio, the main Chilean newspaper.
