BENJAMIN HOBBS

Benjamin F. Hobbs is the Theodore M. and Kay W. Schad Chair of Environmental Management at the Johns Hopkins University, Department of Environmental Health & Engineering. Since 2010, he has been the inaugural Director of the JHU Environment, Energy, Sustainability & Health Institute. He co-directs the Yale-JHU SEARCH (Solutions for Energy, Air, Climate, and Health) Center, funded by the USEPA. Dr. Hobbs chairs the Market Surveillance Committee of the California Independent System Operator, which he has been a member of since 2002. The responsibilities of the committee including advising on market design changes as well as monitoring of market performance and behavior.

Dr. Hobbs' research and teaching concerns the application of optimization and decision analysis to electric utility regulation, planning, and operations and to water and ecosystem management. His publications include three books and 160 journal articles, including several that have won best publications awards.
