He holds a M.S. and Ph.D. in Agricultural Economics from U. Politécnica, Madrid.

His research focuses on the relationship between energy, economics and environment, and specifically on sustainable energy, renewable energy and environmental policy, and multicriteria methods applied to resource allocation. He has published about these issues in most journals relevant in the field. He has also been a consultant for several private and public institutions in Spain, Europe and Latin America.
