FRANCESC POSAS

Francesc Posas is Full Professor of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology at the Department of Experimental and Health Sciences of the Universitat Pompeu Fabra (UPF). After obtaining his doctorate in Biochemistry and Molecular Biology at the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (1995), he made a postdoctoral stay at Harvard University (Boston, USA). From 1999 he leads the Cell Signaling Research Group (<http://www.upf.edu/cellsignaling>). From 2007 to 2013 was Chair of the Department of Experimental and Health Sciences, from 2013 he is the Vice-rector for Science Policy at the UPF. Dr. Posas received the award to Young Investigators from the Catalan Government (2001), EMBO Young Investigator Program (2000), EURYI to young investigators from the EU (ESF) (2004), EMBO member (2006), awarded with an ICREA Academia Researcher for University Professors (2009 and 2014) and the “Carmen and Severo Ochoa” Award for Research in Molecular Biology (2011). He is recipient, together with Dr. Ricard Solé (UPF), of an ERC Advanced Grant with a project based on biological computation (2012). The main focus of Dr. Posas group is the understanding of how cells respond to changes in the environment.
