## **PAUL O'HIGGINS**

Prof. O'Higgins is Head of the Centre for Anatomical and Human Sciences at Hull York Medical School and in the Department of Archaeology, the University of York, England. His research focuses on the evolution and function of the skeletal system, with an emphasis on comparative and developmental studies, particularly of the cranium in humans and our ancestors. This work brings together techniques from imaging, microscopy, geometric morphometrics and finite element analysis to investigate the processes underlying craniofacial development and evolution and to relate form to functional loading.
