Dr. Ravid Straussman was born in Israel. After service in the Israel Air Force, he completed a BS summa cum laude at the Hebrew University Hadassah Medical School in 1997. He earned his MSc in Medical Biochemistry there in 1998 and entered the MD/PhD program. He served his MD internship at Rabin Medical Center in Petach-Tikva (2002 - 2003), and completed his PhD in the Department of Medical Biochemistry in 2005. Dr. Straussman was a postdoctoral fellow in the Department of Cellular Biochemistry and Human Genetics at Hebrew U.

From 2005 to 2008. He worked as a postdoctoral fellow at the Broad institute of Harvard and MIT From 2008 until joining the Weizmann Institute in 2013.

His prizes and honors include the Dean's and Rector's prizes plus an award for excellence in research at the Hebrew University, Hadassah Medical School; a Foulkes Foundation fellowship, a Philip Morris Postdoctoral Fellowship, as well as an American Association for Cancer Research (AACR) scholar-in-training award in 2012.
