JOSEFA ANTÓN

Josefa Antón is associate professor of Microbiology and head of the Molecular Microbial Ecology group of the University of Alicante, Spain. Her research is mainly focused on the microbiota (including viruses) from hypersaline environments and the microbial symbionts of marine invertebrates. One of her main research interests is to understand how microbes interact with viruses in nature. Her group is also interested in deciphering which forces drive and maintain microbial diversity, using aquatic hypersaline environments as model systems. She has published over 60 articles in international journals that have received more than 2400 citations, and has a wide experience in developing molecular microbial ecology techniques, from FISH to viral metagenomics.
