Ricardo Amils has a BS in Chemistry (U. de Barcelona, 1969) and a PhD in Science (U. Autónoma de Barcelona, 1973). Actually he is a Full Professor of Microbiology at the Department of Molecular Biology, U. Autónoma de Madrid, director of the Department of Virology and Microbiology of the Centro de Biología Molecular 'Severo Ochoa' (UAM-CSIC) and senior scientist at the Centro de Astrobiología (INTA-CSIC). He has been working in the physiology of thermophiles, total reconstitution of ribosomes, mode of action of protein synthesis inhibitors and molecular biology of extremophiles. His research in the last thirty years has been oriented towards the microbial ecology of extreme environments, with special dedication to the astrobiological interest of the Río Tinto basin. He has published more than 300 articles in referred journals and book chapters.
