Mar Campins Eritja obtained a Ph.D. in Law at the Universitat de Barcelona in 1991. Since 1994, she is professor in Public International Law (European Union Law) at the Department of International Law and Economics of the Universitat de Barcelona School of Law. Her main fields of teaching and research are: International Environmental Law and European Union Environmental Law, as well as institutional European Union Law. She has been visiting professor and visiting researcher at the Ottawa University (2013), Dalhousie University (2011), Université de Montréal (2009-2010), Nova Southeastern University, Florida (2001) and University of Puerto Rico (1998 and 2015). She has participated in several research projects concerning International and European Environmental Law issues, and she is the author of some books and several articles in these fields. She is member of a High Quality Consolidated Research Working Group at the Universitat de Barcelona; member of the Water Research Institute at the Universitat de Barcelona; and member of the Centre d'Estudis de Dret Ambiental de Tarragona (CEDAT) at the Universitat Rovira i Virgili. She's also an external collaborator of the Centre de Recherche en Droit Public (CRDP) of the Université de Montréal. She is member of the pool of experts for the Institutional Evaluation Programme (IEP) of the European Universities Association (EUA). For several years she served as a Vice-dean of the Faculty of Law (2002-2005), and as Deputy Vice-rector and Vice-rector for International Policy (2005-2008) at the Universitat de Barcelona. She is member of the University Assembly (*Claustro*) of the Universitat de Barcelona (1994 – 2005, and 2010 – present).
