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Marçal Pastor-Anglada is a Professor of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology at the Department of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology at the University of Barcelona (UB). He is also the PI of the Molecular Pharmacology and Experimental Therapeutics (MPET) group within the Oncology Program of the National Biomedical Research Institute of Liver and Gastrointestinal Diseases (CIBER EHD). He has held positions as an INSERM researcher at the CNRS Centre de Recherches sur l'Endocrinologie Moléculaire et le Développement and as a Research Associate at the Department of Cellular, Molecular and Developmental Biology at the University of California Santa Barbara. He has been Visiting Associate Professor at the McArdle Laboratory for Cancer Research, Department of Oncology, University of Wisconsin-Madison School of Medicine and Visiting Professor at the Cellular and Molecular Physiology Laboratory at the Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile. He is the author of more than 160 indexed articles, mostly devoted to the study of membrane transporters. His current interests deal with the pharmacogenetics and pharmacogenomics associated with nucleoside-derived drug based therapies. His laboratory also studies the biology and pharmacology of nucleoside transporter (NT) proteins, with a particular emphasis on the NT interactome as a way to better understand additional biological functions of these plasma membrane proteins.

Major research related managing positions include: Vicerector of Research of the University of Barcelona (2005-2008), Member of the Scientific Board of the International Purine and Pyrimidine Society, Member of the European Science Foundation (ESF) – European Medical Research Council (EMRC) Advisory Board for the Investigator-Driven Clinical Trials initiative (2008), Consultant to Biocat (2009-2010) Project Health Sciences KIC for the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIIT), Life Sciences Coordinator at the Catalan Agency for Research and University Management (AGAUR) (2009- 2011), Member of the External Scientific Advisory Board of the Agency for the Research Centres of Catalonia (CERCA), Founder of the Membrane Transporters Group of the Spanish Society of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology (SEBBM) . Organizer of many workshop and conferences, among them: Transporters 2004, Focused Meeting of the Biochemical Society, UK, Vice-chair of the first European Science Foundation (ESF) Conferences on Biomedicine – Pharmacogenetics of Adverse Drug Reactions, 2008, Organizer of the International Conference on Adenine nucleosides and nucleotides in biomedicine, Purines 2010 and of the 15th Conference of the Purine and Pyrimidine Society (PP2013).
