- Professor of Endocrinology since 1996, University Paris-Sud11)
- Head of the Service of Endocrinology and Reproductive Diseases, in Bicêtre University Hospital, Le Kremlin-Bicêtre, since 2001
- Main interest in Neuroendocrinology: pituitary adenomas including acromegaly, Cushing's disease, TSH-secreting adenomas and non functioning pituitary adenomas.
- Basic Research in INSERM U 1185 on effects of GH on kidney and on pituitary tumorigenesis (AIP) as supervisor of PhD students.
- Clinical research on heart and GH disorders, GH and kidney function, invasiveness of pituitary adenomas, AIP and tumorigenesis, based on large cohorts of patients followed in Bicêtre Hospital (>350 patients with acromegaly, > 1000 prolactinomas...)
- Member of the French Endocrine Society, of the European Society of Endocrinology, of the Endocrine Society, of the Pituitary Society and of the European Neuroendocrine Association (treasurer of the latter since 2009).
- Member of the Editorial Board of Clinical Endocrinology until 2005, of the Editorial Board of the Journal of Clinical Endocrinology and Metabolism until 2010, of "Endocrine" and of "Pituitary" since 2011.
- Principal investigator of numerous trials on treatment of acromegaly (somatostatin analogues, pegvisomant...), treatment by GH of patients with GHD. Principal, investigator of institutional research programs (French Ministry of Health, French Ministry of Research, INSERM...)
- Regular reviewer for many international peer-reviewed journals (J Clin Endocrinol Metab, Clin Endocrinol, Eur J Endocrinol, Pituitary, Circulation, Lancet, Endocr Relat Cancer...)
- Author or co-author of more than 200 original publications in peer-reviewed journals.
