He has done a postdoctoral research fellowship in the laboratory of Prof. Stefan Heller in the US-Universities of Harvard (2005) and Stanford (2006). Since 2007, Dr. Senn's developed an independent research activity focussing on inner ear stem cells, cochlear implants and clinical research projects to improve hearing loss therapies.
